YOU ARE INVITED TO A TALK BY ARION PRESS PUBLISHER ANDREW HOYEM AND SHOW OF ARTIST BOOKS AND PRINTS AT THE OCHI GALLERY IN SUN VALLEY, AUGUST 4-13. OPENING RECEPTION ON AUGUST 4, AT 5 PM.

Artist books and prints from Arion Press, the nation's preeminent creator of limited edition books with contemporary artists, will be at the Ochi Gallery in Ketchum, Idaho, August 3 through 13, with a talk by publisher Andrew Hoyem on August 4 at 5 p.m.

Arion artists on display and include Kiki Smith, Jim Dine, William T. Wiley, Laurie Simmons, Alex Katz, Sol LeWitt, Carroll Dunham, Bruce Conner, Robert Graham, Mel Bochner, Mel Kendrick, and William Matthews.

San Francisco publisher Andrew Hoyem will speak at the opening reception beginning at 5 p.m. on Wednesday, August 4.

Arion Press creates limited edition books that are typeset, printed by letterpress, and hand bound by a team of traditionally-trained craftsmen. Its San Francisco workshop houses a fully functioning typefoundry and has been designated "an irreplaceable cultural treasure" by the National Trust for Historic Preservation. It is one of the last places in the world where the traditional bookmaking crafts, from casting type from metal, through letterpress printing and binding, are practiced under one roof.

The Press has published 88 books since its founding in 1974 by Andrew Hoyem, a typographer and printer who designs every Arion book. Among its best known publications are editions of *Ulysses* with Robert Motherwell, *Cane* with Martin Puryear, *The Apocalypse* with Jim Dine, *Don Quixote* with William T. Wiley, the poetry of Emily Dickinson with Kiki Smith, a handset edition of *Moby-Dick*, and a hand-bound and illuminated Folio Bible.
