Ochi Gallery is pleased to host a trunk show with Ariella Perlman, daughter of violin virtuoso Itzhak Perlman. Perlman's jewelry line is called Magpie Honey (so named as Perlman explains because "Magpies are birds that love things that sparkle, they put tinsel in their nests.")

A native New Yorker, artist, jewelry designer, certified yogi and flutist, Ariella Perlman will debut her new line of jewelry creations at Ochi Gallery. Mrs. Perlman's creations are one of a kind and handmade, using simple techniques, a wide range of materials, and a sophisticated sense of design. Her work also contains a consistent emphasis on ornamentation, from hand-painted details on decoupage pieces, to exacting precision in multi-strand necklaces, Mrs. Perlman assures that every collection is unique. Born the youngest of five in a decidedly artistic household, Mrs. Perlman draws influence from both her upbringing and extensive world travels.

In addition to the classic pieces for which she is known, Mrs. Perlman will also have on display the *Collection Judaica*. This line uses the beauty of the Hebrew language and its characters to create authentic and memorable pieces.

Mrs. Perlman's work has been featured at the Dayton Art Institute, on FOX's American Idol, and boutiques in both Los Angeles and Yellow Springs.
